Patented all-aluminum Alfa LinkTM suspension improves steering feel and stability, while a long list of available driver-assistance features (including Blind Spot Monitoring, Adaptive Cruise Control with Stop & Go, Lane Departure Warning and Autonomous Emergency Brake with Forward Collision Warning help keep drivers on the offensive.
